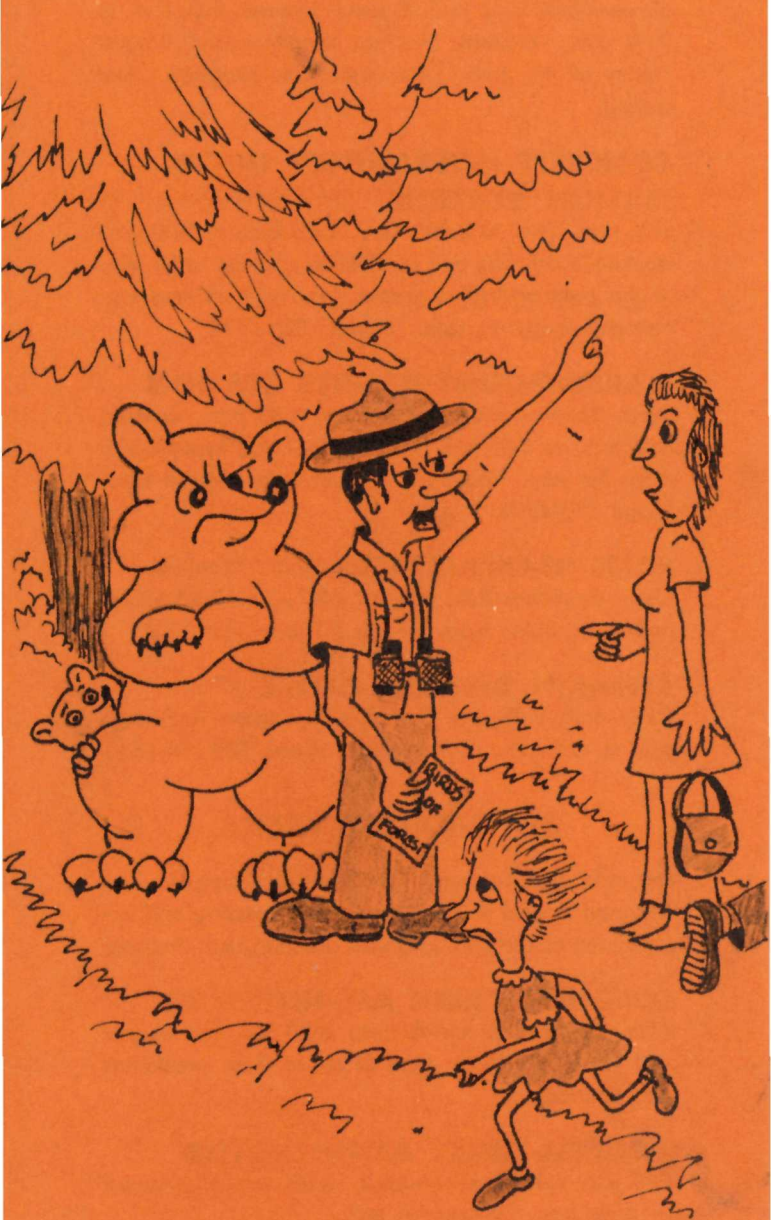


VISITOR ACTIVITIES



VISITOR CENTER AND INFORMATION CENTERS

... are designed to increase your understanding of your park and to aid in obtaining a most enjoyable and safe visit. Here you may obtain information, get backcountry camping permits, purchase publications and see exhibits.

STEHEKIN VISITOR CENTER Open daily all year 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; summer, 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Exhibits illustrate historical and natural history of the area. Automatic slide program. Not staffed.

CONCRETE INTERAGENCY INFORMATION STATION Open daily 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., June to Labor Day; 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekends until the end of October. Large relief map of the park and photographs. Publications and topographic maps for sale. Phone: 853-4111.

MARBLEMOUNT RANGER STATION Open daily all year 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., summer, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Publications and topographic maps for sale. Mountain climbers may register here. Phone 873-4590.

PARK HEADQUARTERS (Sedro Woolley) Open weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Publications and topographic maps for sale. Phone: 855-5731.

STEHEKIN DISTRICT OFFICE (Chelan) Open daily 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. summer daily 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Information. Phone 509-682-2540.

NATURALIST TALKS

The talks, like the rest of the naturalist program, are designed to give you a clearer understanding and appreciation of the park's natural and historical features.

COLONIAL CREEK AMPHITHEATER 9:00 p.m. June to mid-August; 8:30 p.m. mid-August until October. Daily June to Labor Day; weekends until October.

GOODELL CREEK AMPHITHEATER 9:00 p.m. July to mid-August; 8:30 p.m. mid-August to Labor Day. Weekends only.

HOZOMEEN CAMPFIRE CIRCLE 8:30 p.m. July to Labor Day. Saturdays only.

STEHEKIN LODGE 8:30 p.m. July to Labor Day. Daily. Three of these will be trips to the Buckner Ranch.

UNSCHEDULED TALKS

... a little serendipity here. When clear skies or schedules permit, we offer these little discoveries.

ASTRONOMY TALK 10:30 p.m. Diablo Lake Overlook. Clear skies are a must for this one. Bring your binoculars or telescopes.

TRAIL CREW TALK When and if schedules permit, this talk will replace the one given that night at Colonial Creek. They will demonstrate how you pack a mule, among other things.

CONDUCTED TRIPS

On all trips children must be accompanied by a responsible adult, except the trip specifically for children. Wear proper clothing and footwear. Trips may be cancelled due to inclement weather, June to Labor Day.

THUNDER CREEK TRAIL meets Wednesday/Saturday 10:30 a.m. at the Colonial Creek Amphitheater. This two mile, 1½ hour round trip walk features the plant and animal life along a typical lowland valley in the Cascades.

CHILDRENS WALK meets Saturday 10:00 a.m. at Colonial Creek Campground. This one mile, 1½ hour walk exposes the children to the mysteries of nature.

STEHEKIN Schedule will be posted. Short 1 to 2 hour sojourn to the historic Buckner Ranch and other areas of interest around Stehekin.

LADY OF THE LAKE Daily. Naturalist presents an introduction to the North Cascades on the uplake voyage of the Lady of the Lake.

SELF CONDUCTED TOURS On these, the visitor may go at any time and set his own pace. A pamphlet is provided at the trail head; you may either return it to the holder or keep it with our compliments.

RAINBOW MIST NATURE TRAIL ... begins at Rainbow Falls. Allow at least 10 minutes.

ROVING NATURALIST

... is available daily in the early afternoons to interpret the features of the park and to answer your questions. Look for this person at the Diablo and Ross Lake Overlooks.
