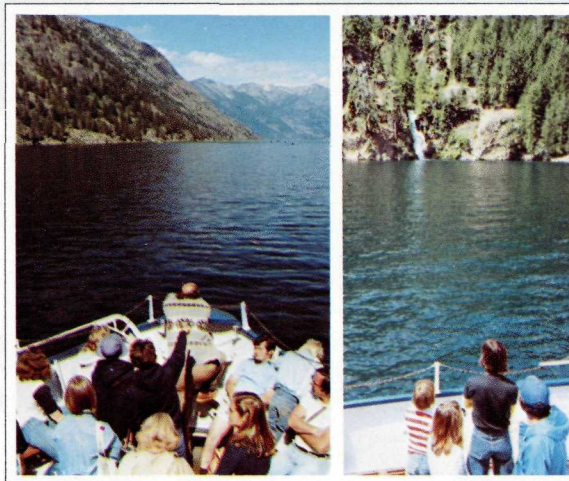

Lake Chelan, nestled in the deepest gorge in North America, is one of Washington's largest inland bodies of fresh water. Though the average width is less than two miles, the lake extends 55 miles into the Cascade Mountains, and dips to over 1500 feet. This means that at its deepest point Lake Chelan drops to 400 feet below sea level. This clear blue lake, fed by 27 glaciers and 59 streams, is recognized as one of the most scenic in the Pacific Northwest. It's also one of the most easily accessible. The city of Chelan, just 35 miles north of

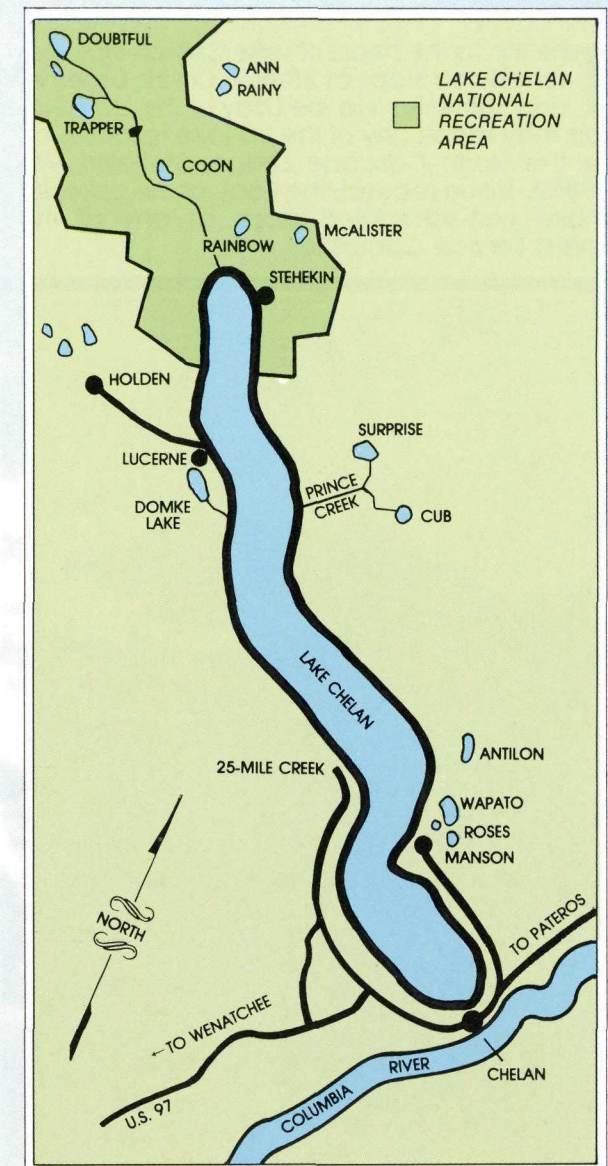


Wenatchee, is in the heart of Washington, approximately 170 miles from both Seattle and Spokane.

Traveling up the lake, which is bordered by rugged mountains in excess of 8000 feet, is a beautiful excursion in all four seasons. In the summer, bask in the sun as you appreciate the contrast of the cool beauty of snow capped peaks. In the fall, the fiery colors of autumn brighten the scene. The new fallen snow



of winter brings mountain goat and deer to the waters edge. And that same snow, melting in the spring brings cascading waterfalls, fresh blossoms, and brilliance back to the mountains. Discover the natural splendor of Lake Chelan, with the Lady of the Lake.
