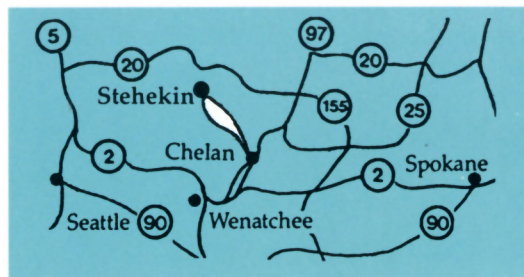
BOATING — Available to rent are small motor boats to explore the shoreline or see 1000 year old Indian paintings. How about fishing for Salmon or Rainbow Trout, which the chef will prepare for your evening dinner . . . or rent a canoe for the quiet and exercise.

HORSEBACK RIDING — Climb further into the Valley on guided horseback to visit our mountain lakes and great scenery.

RIVER RAFTING — Experience the excitement of the Stehekin River a Class 3 whitewater river. See scenery and wild life that make up the Stehekin Valley.

INTERPRETIVE TOURS — Visit historical Buckner Orchard Homestead and pick organically grown apples to press into cider. Or visit the 1 room school house. We offer a scenic valley tour, which gives you insight on this unique community; marvel at the wonder of 312 ft. high Rainbow Falls. Enjoy an informative evening at the Golden West Lodge Museum — program and slide show by the Park Service.

BICYCLING — The most popular way to see the valley. Or if you want, take the bus 10 miles up the valley and ride back to the Lodge (all downhill).



GETTING TO THE LODGE — Remember to make sure we know your mode of transportation to Stehekin — float plane, Lady of the Lake, private boat or plane, or mountain hiking trail; along with your estimated time of arrival.

RESERVATIONS — RECOMMENDED, information and reservations available through our reservations office (509) 682-4711 Monday thru Friday from 8:30 am till 5:30 pm and Saturday from 10 am till 2 pm.

DEPOSIT — After making your reservation, a deposit equal to one nights stay or half the cost of your total stay (whichever is greater), is required within 10 days of confirmation. MasterCard or VISA accepted for payment in full at time of booking. Any remaining balance is required at check-in.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS — We will refund your payment when we have received notification 14 days prior to your arrival. Notification less than 14 days — NO REFUND.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT — Check-out is at 10:30 am and check-in at 12:30 pm. We cannot guarantee an early check-in. You may leave your luggage at the reservations desk in the store, prior to check-in or after check-out.

UNFORTUNATELY — We CANNOT accommodate pets of any kind. None of our rooms offer a tv, radio or phone. (We do have emergency communication.)

NORTH CASCADES LODGE/RESTAURANT — Serving breakfast, lunch and dinner daily May 15 through October 15.

STORE/GIFT SHOP — Open daily. If you have any questions or need to make reservations for tours, boat or bike rentals. We are able to stock our store with limited fresh produce, meats and milk products. Due to the remote location, it is advised that if you have a specific food item, you bring it with you.

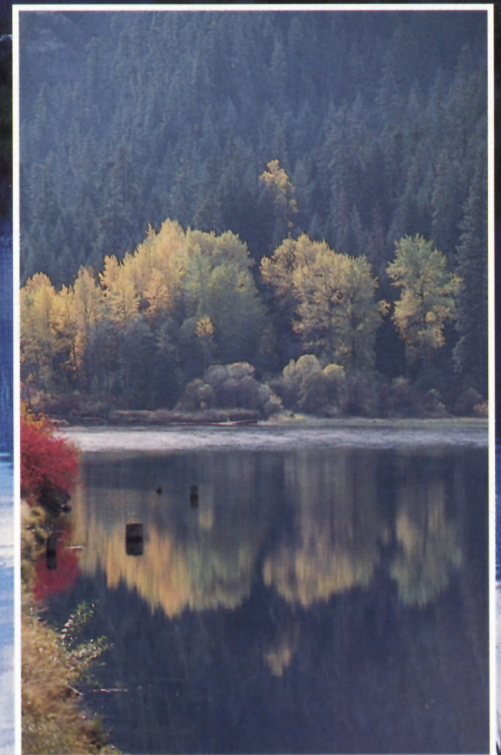


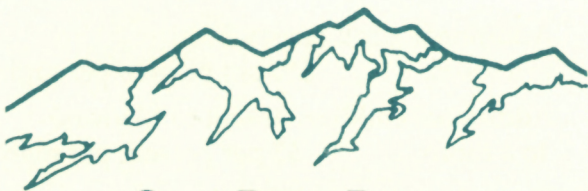

The North Cascades Lodge is nestled in the trees overlooking Lake Chelan at the Stehekin Landing. We at the Lodge invite you to sample some of our "Stehekin Magic." "Stehekin Magic" is a phenomenon that happens to you after a few days in the

most pristine environment one can imagine. First you begin to forget the time of day, then you have to ask what day it is, and finally you allow life's problems to drift out of your mind.

Your "magic" begins with a 55-mile passage through fjord-like Lake Chelan — as clean as the times when Indians summered on its shores. From its waters rise magnificent Castle Peak and McGregor Mountain.





Guest Room Rates

Deluxe Rooms \$65.00

These rooms offer a view of the lake, a queen-size bed or a full-size bed with twin and have either a shower or shower/tub combination.

Standard Rooms \$46.00 - \$55.00

These rooms offer a view of the forest and have a full-size bed or two twin-size beds and have either a shower or shower/tub combination.

Deluxe Family Rooms \$75.00

These are our larger rooms which offer a view of the lake and can accommodate between 4 to 6 guests with various bed configurations; they have either a shower or a shower/tub combination.

Studio Apartments \$65.00

These units offer kitchen facilities, are located on the ground level and have a lake view; with various bed configurations accommodating 2 to 5 guests. They each have their own facilities with a shower.

Deluxe Apartments \$82.00

These units either offer a view of the lake or the forest to accommodate between 4 to 8 guests, with various bed configurations. All units have kitchen facilities and will have a shower or a shower/tub combination.
