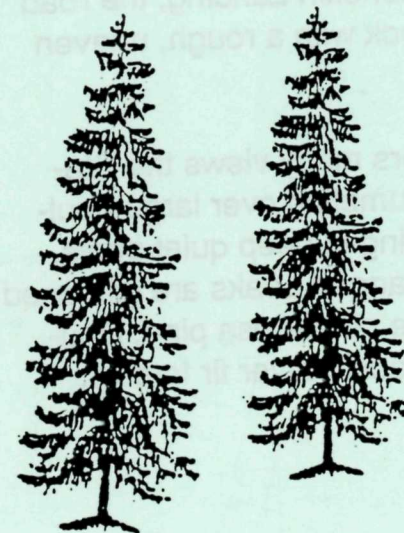

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

The National Park Service offers shuttle bus service along Stehekin Valley Road for your enjoyment and convenience. Rangers provide a narrated tour along the way as well as camping and hiking information. You may get on or off the busses at any location.

A wheelchair lift and infant seats are available on a bus this summer with advance arrangements.

STEHEKIN VALLEY ROAD

The road begins at the Stehekin Landing and is paved for four miles. At Harlequin Campground, asphalt gives way to gravel; Beyond High Bridge, 11 miles from Stehekin Landing, the road is solid bedrock with a rough, uneven surface.

The road offers many views the Stehekin River, tumbling over large boulders and resting in deep quiet pools. Glacier-clad jagged peaks are glimpsed through dense ponderosa pine, Douglas-fir and Pacific silver fir forests.

HOW FAR IS THE ROAD OPEN?

The road is open to Cottonwood, 22.8 miles from Stehekin. Storms or other natural occurrences can damage the road at any time, resulting in road closure. Ask a ranger about changes to this schedule.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are required and can be made up to 30 days in advance by writing to: Shuttle Bus Reservations, National Park Service, P. O. Box 7, Stehekin, WA 98852. Include your name, number in your party, date and time you wish to travel, and where you want to get on and off. Reservations can also be made by contacting a ranger while you are at Stehekin or Marblemount. Shuttle buses hold 14 passengers maximum.

Buses do not leave specified points before the scheduled times. Vehicle, road, medical, or other problems sometimes cause delays.

FEES

Fees are collected to help offset the cost of operating the bus system. Change is available from the rangers who drive the busses, but correct change is always appreciated. Fees are collected for one-way only.

Regular Fare:	\$3.00
Adults over 62:	\$1.50
Children 6-12:	\$1.50
Children under 6:	Free

Annual passes are valid for the calendar year and provide unlimited ridership.

Annual Pass, Adult:	\$15
Annual Pass, Ages 6-12:	\$7.50
Annual Pass, Over 62:	\$7.50
