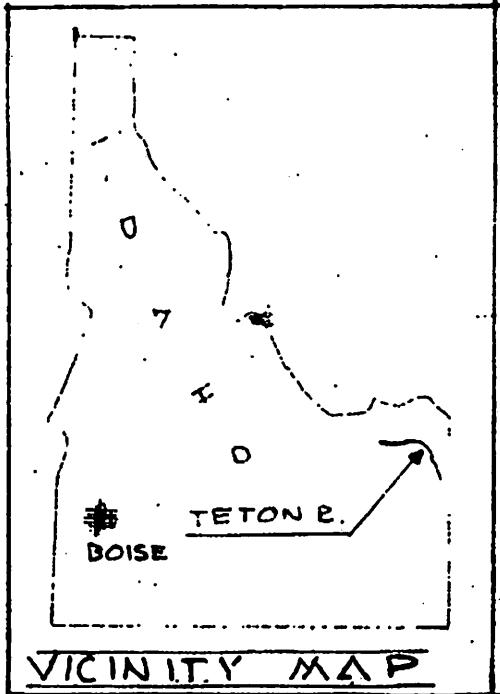
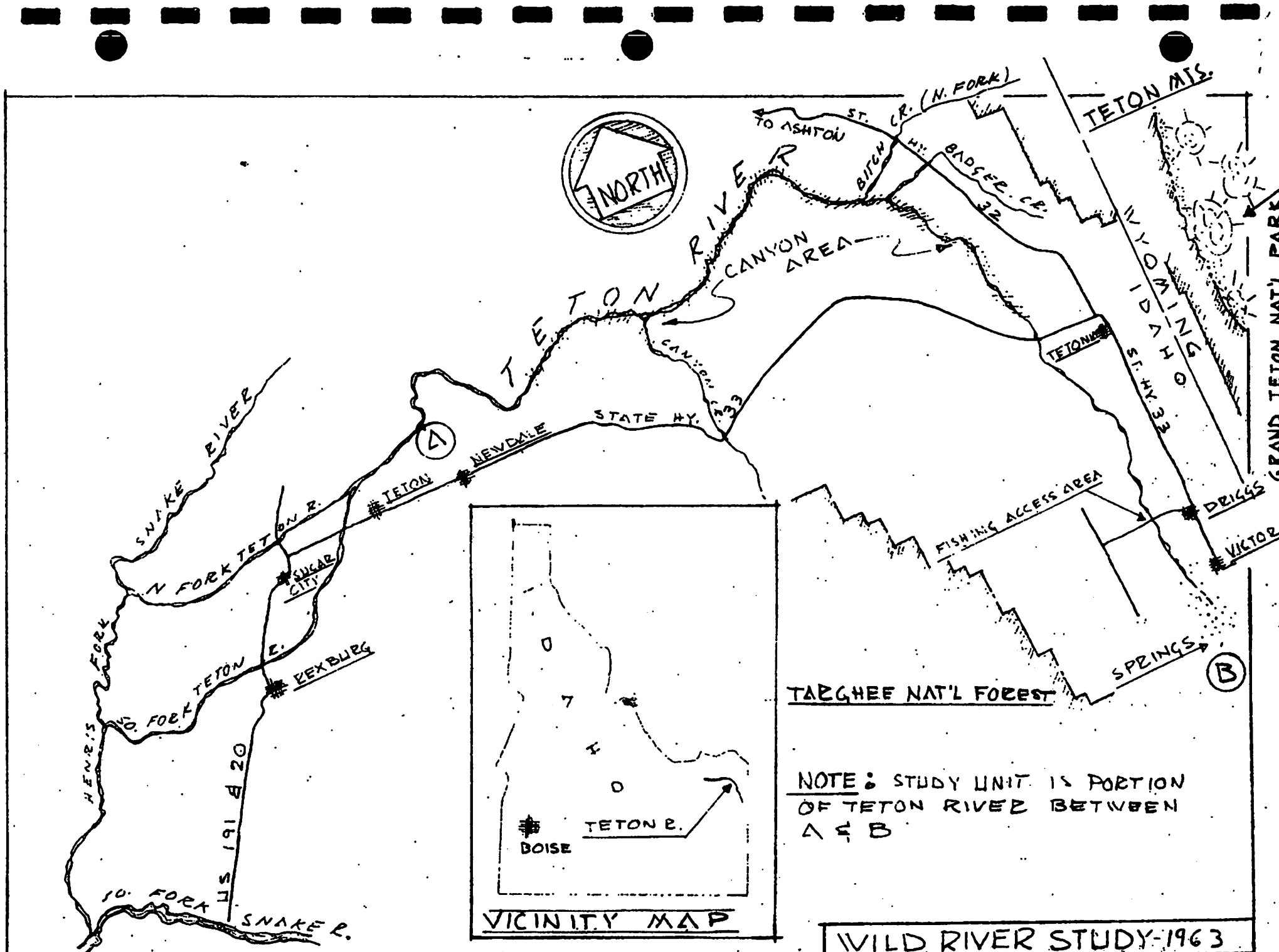
6. Population within 50 miles 125,000; 150 miles 525,000; 250 miles 1,800,000.

7. Weather characteristics by seasons and inclusive dates when study unit is best suited for public use and normal weather conditions during that period

Summer: Warm days and cool nights

Winter: Severe

Average temperature in January is about 18° F., and in July 65° F. Maximum and minimum temperatures range from 100° F. to -37° F. respectively. Average rainfall is about 16 inches which occurs mostly as snow.
