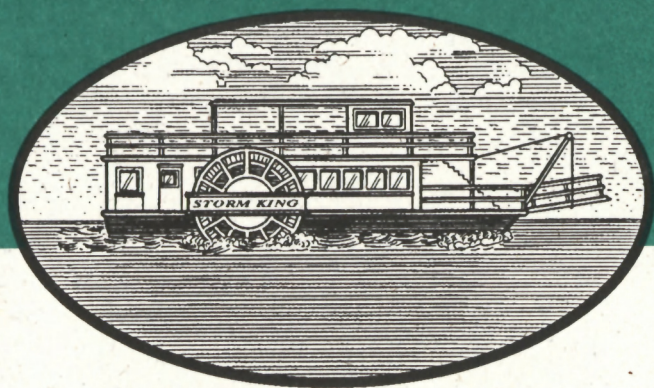

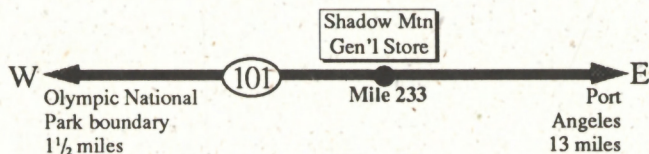
CRUISE SCHEDULE

May 20—October 2.

11:30a, 1:00p, 3:00p, 4:30p, and 6:00p. *Please note that the 6:00p departure operates Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day only.

BOARDING

Please arrive at Shadow Mountain General Store 40-80 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time. The store is located at Mile 233 on scenic Highway 101. Tickets and free parking are available at the store.



SHUTTLE

A shuttle bus departs from Shadow Mountain General Store every half-hour from 10:30 a.m. until 30 minutes prior to the final sailing (with the exception of 11:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.). The return shuttle from the vessel departs on the quarter and three-quarter hour from 10:45 a.m. until 15 minutes after the final docking (with the exception of 11:45 a.m. and 3:15 p.m.).

WHAT TO WEAR AND BRING

Dress is casual. Bring a sweater or jacket and a warm hat so you can enjoy the outside decks; it can be cool and breezy even in good weather. Bring a rain jacket if the weather looks inclement. Wear good walking shoes with rubber soles for safety and comfort. And don't forget your camera and binoculars for better enjoyment of the scenery and wildlife.

SNACKS, BEVERAGES & SMOKING

The vessel has a wide assortment of snacks and beverages available for purchase during the cruise. Smoking is permitted on the outside decks only.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE FOR ANY REASON, EXCEPT FOR CANCELLATION OF THE CRUISE BY MOSQUITO FLEET. If you are forced to change your reservation, you must do so at least two days prior to your cruise date, rebooking on any other date on which space is available during the same cruise season. Reservations are transferable. If Mosquito Fleet is forced to cancel a cruise due to weather or mechanical difficulties, you can rebook on any other date on which space is available during the same cruise season, or you can receive a full refund.
