Primitive Trailheads

BAKER MINE/RED TANKS ROUTE: 3.8 miles from start of Puerto Blanco Drive. A few hundred yards before #3. Marked by brown Wilderness Area beam which blocks it. Park at #3.

DRIPPING SPRINGS MINE ROUTE: 12.3 miles from start of Puerto Blanco Drive. Also .3 miles after #9. On left, after hill. Has Wilderness Area beam and line of stones marking beginning of trail. Park at #9.

MILTON MINE ROUTE: 3.3 miles north of Senita Basin Road junction. Marked by Wilderness Area beam. Park at #24 and walk back to the south \approx 1/2 mile.

OLD AJO/SONOYTA HIGHWAY, E. OF RT. 85: Park on south side of Alamo Canyon road opposite the road that turns off to the north, \approx 100 yards in. Look for stones lining beginning of trail and for cairns.

Or, park at #2 on Ajo Mountain Drive. Trail starts .4 miles after one-way portion of drive begins. Marked by Wilderness Area beam and large rocks blocking the old road.
