Immediately report ALL SIGHTINGS of sea turtles or tracks on the beach
Drive carefully and watch for turtles

KEMP'S RIDLEY NESTING SEASON (APRIL TO MID-JULY)



Nesting Kemp's ridley turtles are about 2 feet long and olive green in color
NESTERS OFTEN CROSS OR NEST IN THE BEACH ROADWAY
OBEY SPEED LIMITS POSTED ON THE BEACH
IMMEDIATELY REPORT ANY SEA TURTLES ON THE BEACH

IF YOU FIND A NESTING TURTLE:

- 1. Stay behind the turtle at least 20 feet, and keep others away.
- 2. If the turtle is returning to the sea, check the turtle's front flippers for tags and record the numbers.
- 3. Mark the nest by placing objects around it, only after the turtle has gone back to the water.
- 4. If possible, wait for a responder.
