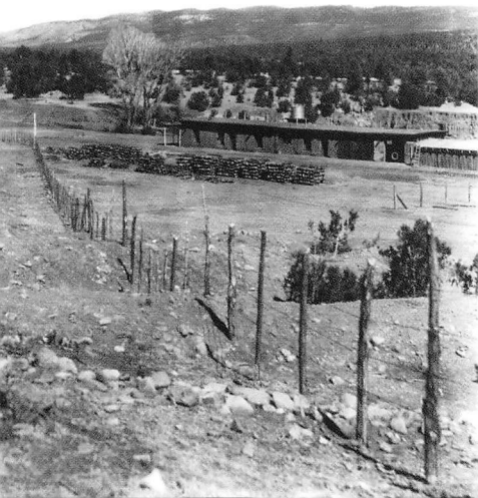


Pecos National Historical Park

Martin Kozlowski operated a ranch and stage stop along the Santa Fe Trail near Pecos Pueblo in New Mexico. He had served in the US Army and allowed Union soldiers to camp on his property during the Civil War. After the Battle of Glorieta Pass, the ranch was used as a Union field hospital.
