Learn how the submariners lived in a narrow metal tube under arduous conditions. Tour many exhibits and learn submarine history. Dive into history for an hour and visit the world of submariners, aquanauts of the sea. See the serene views of the sea and mountains on the shores of Pearl Harbor.

Located just 80 yards from the USS *Arizona* Memorial Visitor Center. Stop in our Gift Shop and capture that perfect Pearl Harbor souvenir!

While at the *Bowfin* purchase your ticket for the Battleship *Missouri* Memorial, the Pacific Aviation Museum and the shuttle to the USS *Oklahoma* Memorial. Catch the bus to Ford Island at the entrance to Bowfin Park.

The Submarine

Go below deck aboard the USS *Bowfin* (SS-287). Launched on December 7, 1942, she was nicknamed the "Pearl Harbor Avenger" and sank 44 enemy ships during the course of her nine war patrols.

Pacific Submarine Museum

Explore the fascinating history of submarines from the first daring attempt in 1776 to use a submersible in warfare to the feats of today's nuclear submarines.



The Memorial

Pause to reflect at the Waterfront Memorial, which stands in silent tribute to the 52 American submarines and the more than 3,500 submariners lost in World War II.
