A BILL

For establishing a Forestry Experimental Station and National Park at the "Old Stockade," near Millen, in Jenkins County, Georgia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That as a memorial and to preserve it, for its historic interest,
4 the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture is hereby
5 authorized and directed to acquire by purchase, condemna-
6 tion, or otherwise, the tract of land near Millen, in Jenkins
7 County, Georgia, known as the "Old Stockade," on which
8 site was located a prison during the War between the States
9 and to establish thereon a station for the purpose of making
10 experiments and study in reforesting the lands of that entire

1 section with pine trees, and other commercially valuable
2 timbers and trees, that grow in that climate and to preserve
3 the same as a national park.

4 SEC. 2. That for the purposes stated, and for the erec-
5 tion of suitable buildings and obtaining necessary equip-
6 ment, and for other items, incident to operating and making
7 such forestry experiments, as well as for properly marking
8 and preserving the same as a park aforesaid, there is hereby
9 authorized to be appropriated the sum of \$50,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, out of any moneys in the
11 Treasury not otherwise appropriated for said purposes, to be
12 expended under the direction of the Secretary of the Depart-
13 ment of Agriculture.

9 authorized to be appropriated the sum of \$50,000, or so much

11 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for said purposes, to be
