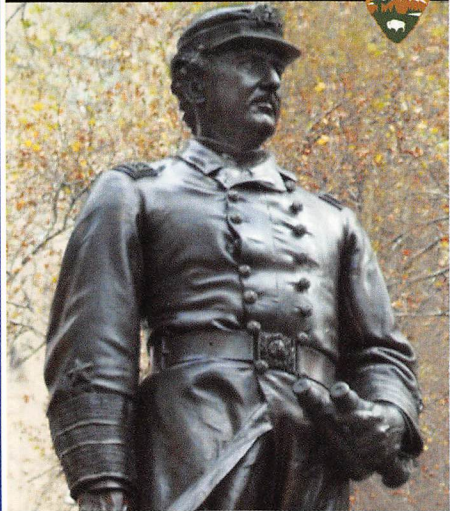

The Farragut Monument

By Augustus Saint-Gaudens (1848-1907)

Bronze, 12 ft. high

The monument to Admiral David Glasgow Farragut was unveiled in Madison Square Park in New York City in 1881. Farragut was the hero of the naval battles of New Orleans and Mobile Bay, and remembered for his order “Damn the torpedoes, full steam ahead!” The original base and a bronze cast of the statue are exhibited at Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site.
