
Circle X Ranch Site Visitor Facilities



Camping Information

ucked in the canyons above Malibu and nestled below majestic
Sandstone Peak lies Circle X Ranch. Though relatively close to the
hustle and bustle of Los Angeles, a sense of peace will overtake you
upon entering this secluded mountain retreat.

A superb site for a rustic camping experience, Circle X also offers several trails with scenic views and opportunities for wildlife observation. Combine your group camping adventure with meetings or a training session at the Ranch House. Explore a portion of the Backbone Trail as you hike to the Backcountry Campground. Whatever your preferred camping experience, it is sure to be an enjoyable and memorable one.



Accessible by vehicles less than 25 feet total length (trailers prohibited).

All sites are tent camping only. Sites are walk-in only with some located several hundred yards from the parking area. Vehicles are not permitted in campsites.

Charcoal fires are permitted in fire grates or personal barbecue grills. Gas stoves are permitted. **Wood or compressed log fires are prohibited.** Quiet hours are 10pm to 6am. Dogs are permitted on leash only.

Fee: \$6 per site per night (Golden Age and Golden Access passport discounts apply). All sites are first-come first-served. Registration is self-serve. Limit of 6 persons, two vehicles and two tents per site. You must vacate site by noon or pay for another day of camping.

Group Campground

Accessible by vehicle.

Charcoal fires are permitted in fire grates or personal barbecue grills. Gas stoves are permitted. Wood or compressed log fires are prohibited. Dogs are permitted on leash only.

Fee: \$2 per person per night (Golden Age and Golden Access passport discounts do not apply). Available by reservation only. Limit of 75 persons.

Backcountry Campground

Accessible by foot, bike or horse.

Gas stoves only. **Wood, compressed log and charcoal fires are prohibited.** Dogs are not permitted.

No fee. For required permit and info: 310-457-6408 Circle X Ranch or 805-499-4101 Rancho Sierra Vista/ Satwiwa Ranger Station

Note: Maximum stay in any of the campgrounds is 14 consecutive days and no more than 30 days/calendar year.

Other Facilities

Ranch House


The ranch house is available through reservation and special use permit. This facility includes a meeting room for 75 people, kitchen and restrooms. No overnight accommodations are available. To reserve this facility: 310-457-6408.

Swimming Pool

Safety Information

Be prepared: take water, food, flashlights, and first-aid supplies when hiking.

Camping is restricted to established campgrounds only. Permits are required.

Water from streams is not safe to drink due to possible contamination or the presence of the giardia protozoan.

Dogs must be leashed at all times, and are allowed only on trails, access roads and in campgrounds. *Note: State parks do not allow dogs*.

Fire is a constant danger. Open fires are prohibited. Charcoal and gas stoves are

allowed in Happy Hollow and the Group campgrounds only. Smoking is not permitted while traveling on trails.

Natural and historic features are protected by law and may not be collected. Watch for and avoid rattlesnakes and poison oak.

Bicyclists must ride courteously and yield to hikers and horseback riders. Bicycles are allowed on fire roads, but not on trails.

Hikers must yield to horseback riders.

Firearms are not allowed in National Park Service areas.

Trail closures will be in effect during and following significant rainfall to protect park resources. Trails will be reopened when dry enough to sustain public use.
