CEDAR GROVE, is the terminus of the new highway into the Kings River Canyon. Here are located a market and camper's supply store; a lunchroom including soft drinks; and gasoline and oil.

GOVERNMENT—Sequoia National Park and Kings Canyon National Park are under the charge of Superintendent E. T. Scoyen. All National Parks are under the control of the National Park Service of the Department of the Interior, Newton B. Drury, Director.

BEARPAW MEADOW CAMP, in Sequoia Park, is reached by hiking or horseback along the High Sierra Trail, 11 miles from Crescent Meadow. Altitude 7,800 feet. In the midst of some of the most spectacular scenery in the High Sierra, and some of the best fishing waters. Providing plain but comfortable tent accommodations enabling one to travel unencumbered except for camera, fishing rod and personal necessities. Sleeping accommodations, one or two persons in a tent, \$2.00 per person per day. Meals \$1.50 each. No children's rates. Season approximately last week in June to first week in September.

AUTUMN SEASON—Sequoia National Park is open all the year, and comfortable cabins affording all types of summer service on a limited capacity are available throughout the Autumn.

STAGE TRANSPORTATION

SEQUOIA AND GRANT GROVE

RAILROAD AND STAGE SERVICE TO BOTH PARKS: Sequoia and Grant Grove stages meet Southern Pacific and Santa Fe trains and Santa Fe and Pacific Greyhound stages at Fresno, California, and connect with planes of United Air Lines, at the same point, and at Visalia.

Note: Passengers from Los Angeles coming via Southern Pacific Daylight Streamliner connect with Sequoia and Grant Grove stages at Visalia.

Note: In Fresno stage stops at all rail and bus depots, first, on arrival at 12:15 p.m. to discharge outgoing passengers, and again between 1:30 and 2:00 p.m. to pick up incoming passengers before leaving the Hotel Californian at 2:00 p.m. In Visalia stops are also made at all rail and bus depots to pick up passengers.

CIRCLE TOUR STAGE SERVICE TO BOTH PARKS: Leave Fresno (Hotel Californian) 2:00 P.M.; leave Visalia (Hotel Johnson) 3:25 P.M.; arrive Giant Forest Lodge, SEQUOIA NATIONAL PARK, 6:15 P.M. Leave Giant Forest Lodge 8:00 A.M.; leave Grant Grove Lodge, KINGS CANYON NATIONAL PARK, 9:40 A.M.; arrive Fresno, 12:15 P.M. Above schedule daily May 22nd to September 13th, inclusive. FARES: Round trip from Fresno or Visalia, on above circle tour schedule, \$10.00, plus Federal Tax, 15%. Children 6 to 11 years, inclusive, half fare.
