

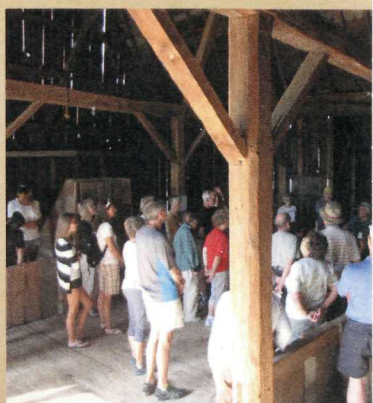

Port Oneida Farms Heritage Center

Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore has over 360 historic structures and landscapes. Enjoy the pastoral beauty and educational offerings of this rich landscape. Start your experience at the Olsen farm exhibits. Get your Port Oneida Tour Guide Booklet there and explore the farms by trail or car. *Open: July 7–Labor Day Tues.-Sat. 11-5, Sunday 1-4. Labor Day–mid October, Sat-Sun 1-4.*

Horse and Wagon

Guided Driving Tours

The Park's historic properties include farms, log cabins, inns, and maritime buildings. Caravan with our guide and tour the buildings to learn about the settler's way of life. *Wednesdays 10 am & 7 pm. July 10–August 7. Free.*

Natural and cultural resources merge on our walking tours, *Tuesdays and Thursdays at 10 am. Different walking & meeting locations each day. July 9–August 29. Free.*
