Steamtown's Mission:



From Interstate 81, Exit 185: Follow Central Scranton Expressway to the first traffic light and turn left. This road bears right and becomes Lackawanna Avenue. Follow Lackawanna past seven sets of lights. The entrance is on the left at Cliff Avenue.
