Who Are The Friends?

The Friends of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial is a non-profit, non-political membership organization dedicated to furthering the healing effects of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. It ensures that the historical significance and emotional legacy are not lost to future generations.

The organization was formed in 1986 by volunteer guides at the Memorial to assist the National Park Service in helping visitors to the Memorial, and to undertake projects that enhance and extend the healing nature of the Memorial for all Americans.

- *In Touch* — A locator program that brings family and friends together with veterans who served with their loved ones. Special groups of sons, daughters, brothers, and sisters have developed support networks.
- *In Memory* — A unique memorial program honoring those veterans who returned from Vietnam, but who died prematurely because of their experience and the civilians killed in Vietnam.
- *In Honor* — A service in which we will fly an American flag at our information booth on the grounds of the Memorial. A flag can be flown in honor of a specific person, unit, or date.
- *Father's Day Remembrance Project* — The placing of a rose and a message at the Wall for you on Father's Day.
- *Name Rubbing Program* — A process where a sheet of paper is placed over a name on the Memorial and the image of the name is transferred to the paper. Over 25,000 rubbings have been provided to individuals who could not come to the Memorial.
- *Friends' Information and Assistance Booth* — Information site maintained at the Memorial, where hundreds of people each day find our booth to be a welcome and valuable resource. We staff individuals willing and able to answer questions, provide guidance, or just listen.
- *Visiting Volunteer Program* — Part of our outreach program. The program brings individuals from outside of the Washington area to the Memorial so that they can experience the power of the Memorial and carry that experience back to their community. (Must be sponsored by a community organization.)
- *Guest Book (at the Memorial)* — Visitors record their reactions to the Memorial.
- *Audio Cassette Tour (future)* — Available at the Friends' Information and Assistance Booth, this tour will acquaint visitors with some of the history of the Memorial and will relate some of the stories that have made the Wall the phenomenon that it is today.
- *Newsletters* — Available to our members. Stories about our programs and events at the Memorial.

The Friends' programs are designed to promote our mission and all proceeds from sales go to support our projects which are offered to the public *free of charge*.

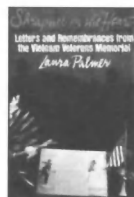

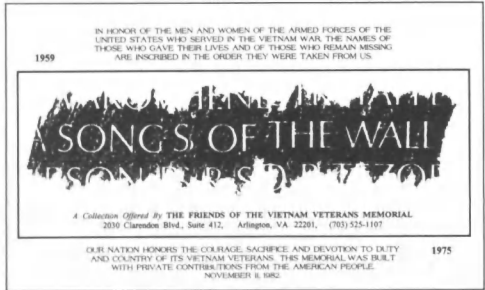

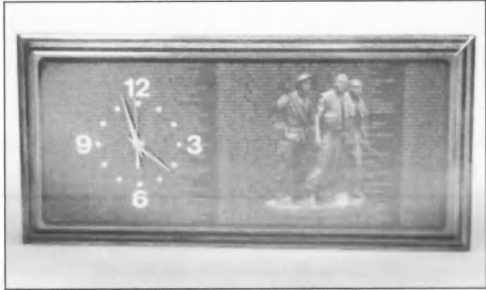
