The park's Visitor Center is open Wednesday through Sunday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Come stand face to face with the convention organizers at "The First Wave" statue exhibit, explore the interactive exhibit area, and view "Dreams of Equality", a dramatization of the First Women's Rights Convention in 1848.

Ranger guided tours step off from the Visitor Center at 10:30 am and 1:30 pm to explore the Wesleyan Chapel, where the women's rights movement had its formal beginnings. Join us for these 30 minute programs.

Following the Wesleyan Chapel tour, meet the ranger at the Elizabeth Cady Stanton House at 11:30 am and 2:30 pm. These programs explore the home that Elizabeth Cady Stanton lived in when she helped launch the largest social movement in history.
