Since Yellowstone National Park was established in 1872, three hundred and thirty species of birds have been documented. This is quite remarkable, especially when you consider the harsh environmental conditions that characterize the area. The diversity is due to the variety of habitat types here, from lower elevation sagebrush-grasslands and riparian-willow communities to high elevation alpine meadows and whitebark pine forests.

The Yellowstone National Park Bird Program monitors a variety of birds and invites your participation. We designed this checklist to provide you with an up-to-date list of the park's birds, following the guidelines of the American Ornithologists Union (AOU). It also provides an observation form so you can contribute your sightings to the park's data, which will enhance our knowledge of Yellowstone's bird life.

We thank Lisa Baril, Mark Donahue, Katy Duffy, Leslie Henry, and John Parker for helpful suggestions to the checklist.
