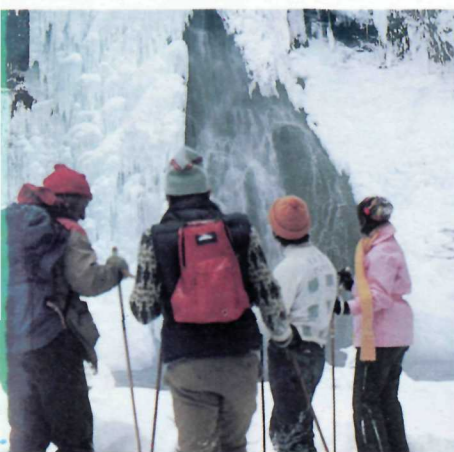
Old Faithful Snow Lodge

Snowmobiles Welcome

It's a challenge to take your own snowmobile into the Park. Over 150 miles of groomed roads make up one of the largest areas in the country with maintained trails for snowmobilers. For your convenience, snowmobile fuel, both premixed and non-mixed, is available at Old Faithful Snow Lodge, along with snowmobile oil and a variety of emergency repair parts such as drive belts and spark plugs for do-it-yourself maintenance. Also at Old Faithful is the Four Seasons Snack Shop, especially for winter sports enthusiasts who are looking for a quick, hot snack. At Canyon, vending services and gasoline services are available at the warm-up hut. Limited hot food is also available.

Snowcoach Daytime Expedition

Come along on a day filled with Yellowstone adventure by snowcoach. Ride a big, heated ten passenger coach over deep snow in warm comfort. Informal narration by a knowledgeable driver/host will deepen your appreciation of this unique winter experience.

A journey to Old Faithful will take you along steaming rivers and snowy meadows where elk and bison browse. You'll see the famous geyser basins and a performance of Old Faithful in winter dress. And you'll have time for a visit at Snow Lodge where the restaurant and snack shop are open.

An odyssey to the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone will glide you through deep forests to one of America's great scenic wonders — a canyon of ice and snow. Box lunches may be purchased at Old Faithful Snow Lodge or limited hot food is available at the Canyon warm-up hut. All trips are round trip.
