I. and is now a pensioner on the rolls of the United States Number 36828; that he lost the sight of both his eyes by a gun shot wound at the battle of Gettysburgh while in the military service of the United States; that in consequence of this loss of sight - he is permanently and totally disabled as to require the regular presence, aid and attendance of another person to prepare his food for him, to conduct him from place to place and to perform such other duties as personal needs constantly require. He further says that without such regular attendance he would suffer for the ordinary comforts of life.
